Registration

Level Test

It is important that you complete the level test before arrival. If your level is found to be below the minimum level for the course, we reserve the right to modify the number of lessons.

Course Modification

For group courses the number of hours will be modified if a minimum of 4 students are not enrolled at the same level.

Visas

To obtain the necessary course confirmation documents from us to apply for a visa, a deposit of £500 must be paid when booking.

If a student's visa application is rejected after payment has been received, we will refund the full amount paid (minus £50 administration fee) once we have received a copy of the visa refusal letter.
